Hallindens Granit's operations are built on a family history as solid as granite. Both the quarries and the company have been passed down through several generations. The company history started with Tossene, which was the first quarry to open, in 1946, as part of a stonemasonry business on Sotenäset. Today, the company is owned and run by Jörgen and Johan Lundgren, who uphold the legacy of their father and the generations before him - a legacy that has helped the Swedish west coast maintain its position as the heart of Sweden's stone industry through the centuries. In 1982, Hallindens Granit took over operations at Skarstad, the quarry that today serves as the company's base. The company now operates a total of seven quarries: four in Bohuslän, two in Småland, and one in Halland.


Industrial-scale quarrying has taken place in the region since the first half of the 19th century, but production gained real momentum when the roughly 80-kilometer long Trollhätte Canal began construction in 1842. Today, the Bohuslän stone industry still accounts for a significant portion of Sweden's stone production, even though it employs far fewer people, thanks to efficiency improvements and modern production methods. Moreover, Swedish companies can now showcase some of the world's best working environments in quarrying. Hallindens Granit works long-term to restore both local and Swedish industrial traditions.

Local materials, adapted to our climate and requiring no long transports, are always the best choice - both economically and from a sustainability perspective. Traditional Swedish natural stone has by far the lowest environmental impact compared to other materials. Durability has always been at the heart of natural stone, regardless of type or context.

At Hallindens Granit, we continually refine and develop our production. We are constantly working on renewal and improvement, to be able to meet the wishes and requirements of our customers. Today, we make use of every piece of stone produced in our quarries, with even the smallest fragments being recycled back into the stone's own cycle. Combine this with our Swedish work environment, and you have an unbeatable combination that no other country can match.



OUR STONE TYPES

From a geological perspective, Bohus Granite is one of Sweden's youngest granites. Its mineral composition creates its characteristic color variation. Like all granites, it is highly resistant to weathering and requires very little maintenance. The uniform fine-grained texture is a distinctive hallmark. We also quarry Gneiss in Halland, as well as black Diabase and red Granite in Småland. Our natural stone has a wide range of applications, from paving stones to facades, stairs, walls, poles, flooring, wall cladding, windowsills and countertops.



TOSSENE Grey Bohus
Grey Granite with a unique, warm tone, even structure and color.



SVENSTORP Hallandia
Gneiss with a warm red and black tone, featuring a flamed/veined pattern.



SILVER Grey Bohus
Grey Granite with an even, light color and distinct granularity.



MOHEDA Swedish Black
Deep black Diabase, dark and fine-grained.



SKARSTAD Red Bohus
Red Granite with a warm red color, medium to coarse-grained texture.



TRANAS Classic
Granite with a warm reddish tone, featuring hints of black and grey.



BROBERG Red Bohus
Red Granite with a warm red color, medium-grained texture.
